Dr. Greg Forzley is the Chief Medical Information Officer for Health Networks with Trinity Health, based in Livonia, MI. In his current role, he is responsible for supporting the development, implementation and use of clinical information systems to assist clinicians within the health networks in the delivery of the highest quality and most appropriate patient care. Prior to this, he was the CMIO at Saint Mary's Health Care in Grand Rapids, MI for 10 years.
