Jennifer Fine is one of the founding members of the UCLA Mattel Children's Hospital Parents Advisory Council. For the past four years, she has been leading programs that improve the patient and family experience, while partnering with staff and administration to help implement the changes conceived by this group. In 2008, at just 6 months of age, her younger daughter, Ella, was diagnosed with stage 4 hepatoblastoma, and she and Ella called UCLA their home for almost eight months while undergoing chemotherapy, three liver transplants in ten days, and an anoxic brain injury. Being both medically fragile and severely disabled, Ella continues to be a "frequent flyer" within the UCLA Health System. In 2012, Jennifer became a patient of UCLA, when she herself was diagnosed with low grade ovarian cancer, which she continues to battle today. In her spare time, Jennifer works full-time as a Project Manager for Johnson & Johnson Consumer Products, and raises both her daughters, now five and six, with her husband here in Los Angeles.
