Dr. Hoffman has been involved in creation of numerous technology-based interventions and assessments for web and mobile platforms including, most notably, the congressionally mandated afterdeployment.org and the multi-award winning PTSD Coach mobile app. She currently leads multi-disciplinary teams of subject matter experts, software engineers, designers, project managers, and researchers to build a suite of mobile applications to support Veterans, families, and healthcare providers. She is actively engaged in creation of governance and policy for development and deployment of technologies in Federal systems. She is additionally a Faculty Affiliate of the DoD's National Center for Telehealth & Technology, where she was previously Mobile Apps Lead, core faculty at the NIH mHealth Institute, and the Director of the Mobile Behavior Design Lab at the National Center for PTSD.
